

### Challenge

#### Two problems, no traditional solution

Due to the pandemic, ASCE observed a precipitous drop in proceedings output in 2020. This disrupted content outcomes and in-person events, causing a long-term strategic shift for ASCE and how they approach conferences. As a result, ASCE transitioned to virtual events, quickly accruing thousands of hours of video with no cohesive content strategy in place for consolidating, organizing, or structuring their video content.

The pandemic shined a light on how important it was to start thinking differently about technology and how ASCE can deliver content using different mechanisms.
